

**Catskill Town Board Committee Meeting – Catskill Town Hall**  
**February 19, 2020      6:30 pm**

Supervisor Finch opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance. The following were discussed:

**RICKY CRAMER BALL FIELD:**

Supervisor Finch has reached out to several companies for a quote to repair/replace fencing. Will contact if we do not hear from them shortly.

Looking to have field ready by spring. In regards to the trees, may be able to have the county help. If not, will need to hire a tree contractor.

**SENIOR CENTER:**

Supervisor Finch is trying to find a Zumba instructor to hold classes there. It is has been difficult. He is also looking at different programs to schedule for the seniors.

**LITTLE RED SCHOOLHOUSE:**

Garbage overflowing. Smoking at gazebo. Councilman Vosburgh stated there is no smoking at town owned facilities. Councilman McCulloch stated to put a carry in/carry out sign there and at RCF and to speak to administration at the nursing home regarding no smoking policy.

**AMBULANCE:**

Huber Enterprises inspected the furnace and will give price for on demand electric hot water and gas.

**BOARD COMMENT:**

Councilman McCulloch stated we have three surplus ambulances we cannot sell. Jack Ormerod asked about donating one to a fire company in West Virginia who is in need. All were in agreement to donate the 2010 E350 Ford.

The two new snowplow purchase will be from a munibid. The cost per truck is \$139,057 with an additional \$90,884 to up fit making total cost per snowplow \$229,941. The town will bond \$450,000 and the additional money will come from Shawn's budget.

Supervisor Finch stated he is working with the Assessor on the solar pilot.

**PUBLIC COMMENT:**

Frances Spark and Margaret Tomlinson were present from the Community Center to discuss with the board their finances and the need for their services to the community. She stated they need the board's

funding as without it they will not be able to continue. The funding will get them through the Summer Rec program and by that date, they will have plans further clarified than now.

Councilman McCulloch stated the funding was approved in the budget but would like to see the Community Center's budget. After discussion, the Community Center will send their monthly financial status.

#### HIGHWAY:

Councilman McCulloch revisited the snowplow purchase for the highway and stated we need a resolution on our intent to purchase. *Resolution # 10-2020 on motion of Councilman Vosburgh second by Councilwoman Scannapieco declaring the boards intent to purchase two (2) 2021 Western Star PRL-20W Snowplows under a municipal bid with Onondaga County in the amount of \$459,882 with \$450,000 being bonded and the remaining \$9,882 from the highway budget. Adopted Vote: 5 Yes*

With no further business Councilman Giordiano motioned to enter into executive session to discuss a union contract. No further business will be discussed after the end of executive session. Councilman Vosburgh seconded the motion. Executive session began 7:48 pm.

Motion to exit executive session and end the meeting was made by Councilman Giordiano second by Councilman Vosburgh. Meeting ended 8:24 pm.
