Acting Supervisor Walsh opened the meeting with a moment of silent prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Acting Supervisor Walsh stated there are two proclamations this evening and asked Councilman Lennon to present them.

Councilman Lennon stated the proclamations are for John Killinger, a volunteer fireman for the Palenville Fire Department, and Alfie Beers, Highway Superintendent. Councilman Lennon read the proclamations aloud. They were awarded for bravery and heroism for helping rescue a mother and small child from rapidly rising flood waters at their home due to the overflow of the Kaaterskill Creek during a rain storm in December of 2010.

Acting Supervisor Walsh polled the board. No one had anything to discuss.

Acting Supervisor Walsh thanked Mr. Killinger and Mr. Beers on behalf of the citizens of Catskill stating we are proud. He opened the floor for public comment.

Alfie Beers stated the creek project's permits in Palenville are good to September 30th. He stated there is no trouble with the water to the bridge but the stream has to get cut out a bit. He also stated on Mountain House Road there has been flooding and he will have to raise the road three feet. He stated the County will help with this project.

Acting Supervisor Walsh asked if there were any other public comment. With no other business he asked for a motion to enter into executive session to discuss pending litigation. Motion was made by Councilman Lennon and seconded by Councilman Smith. Executive session started 6:51 pm.

Motion was made by Councilman Antonelli and seconded by Councilman Smith to exit executive session and end the meeting. Meeting ended 7:50 pm.
