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Supervisor McCulloch opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

ARPA Funds – We received an email from Greene County that they wish to distribute another round of ARPA monies for projects involving recreation/youth or Veterans. We have discussed the replacement of the scoreboard at the field. Jared has received quotes. Councilman Espel mentioned installing a light near the playground. Councilman Giordiano stated replacing the field lights would be \$40,000 with the town providing the poles. Supervisor McCulloch stated we can decide next month and send a letter to the county.

ARPA Funds – Supervisor McCulloch stated Kirsten had a webinar about the upcoming procedures and we need a solid plan of what to do with the ARPA funds by December.

Comp Plan – Supervisor McCulloch received an email regarding a grant opportunity for the comprehensive plan. We have until July 31st to apply. He will work with Teresa and DE. Our match would be 20%.

Roof Town Hall – it has leaked again. We will contact the contractor who replaced the highway roof.

Code Vehicle – Councilman Giordiano would like to surplus the code vehicle and purchase from the Village of Catskill the Tahoe in the amount of \$8,000. He would also like to have an RFP for the purchase of the electric vehicle for Code. *Resolution # 59-2024 on motion of Councilman Giordiano second Councilwoman Scannapieco to solicit RFP's for a 2024 BEV ½ ton crew cab pickup truck for the Code Department. Adopted Vote: 4 Yes 1 Absent (Kozloski) Resolution # 60-2024 on motion of Councilman Giordiano second Councilwoman Scannapieco to declare the 2008 Chevrolet Blazer surplus property and have the Highway Superintendent place it for auction. Adopted Vote: 4 Yes 1 Absent (Kozloski) Resolution # 61-2024 to purchase the 2010 Chevy Tahoe from the Village of Catskill in the amount of \$8,000. Adopted 3 Yes 1 Abstention (McCulloch) 1 Absent (Kozloski)*

Senior Center – Councilwoman Scannapieco stated the banner will have the added two recommendations to it. She was there on Monday and there were 7 people present. They stated it was a slow day.

Ambulance – Councilman Espel asked if George has given us the updated uniform policy. Supervisor McCulloch stated not yet.

Supervisor McCulloch mentioned the following events: Honor a Veteran Ceremony will be at the point at 1 pm on Saturday; Memorial Day Parade May 27th at 2 pm; Clean-up Day June 23rd from 7:30 am to 2:30 pm at the Greene County Transfer Station.
