Supervisor Davis opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance. There is no set agenda.

Town Court gave their quarterly report and it is tracking. Judge Wootton submitted a 90 day medical leave. Judge Jacobs will be filling in for him. OCA has been notified.

Vincent Seeley, President of the VOC, sent an email with instructions to the public to contact 943-2244 for this weekend's heat advisory in case of rolling black outs. The Community Life Church will be a relief zone and the Senior Center will be a backup.

A letter was received from Anthem Sports for this year's 12th Tour the Catskills Cycling Race being held August 3rd.

A quote was received from Patterson Pest Control for Town Hall, PBA and Ambulance building. One time start-up fee of \$450 with bi-monthly service calls or as needed.

Received a SEQRA from NY Power Authority regarding their security for telecomm system throughout the state. Supervisor will sign we do not want to be an involved agency.

Councilman Giordiano stated Highway Superintendent Beers purchased a leaf vac and arm mower for the tractor through another mini-bid. *Resolution # 51-2019 on motion of Councilman Giordiano second by Councilwoman Scannapieco authorizing the Highway Superintendent spend up to \$28,000 for a leaf vacuum and arm mower on muni-bid. Adopted Vote: 5 Yes*

Councilman McCulloch asked about the thruway. Supervisor Davis stated it is information as the tolls are going to be cashless.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Mr. Stickles of Bethel Ridge Road presented the board with a petition for a speed limit on said road. Supervisor Davis stated we support the position and will send to the Greene County Highway Superintendent who will forward to State DOT.

Supervisor Davis stated the wood under the bridge on Cauterskill will be looked at by the county.

After a brief discussion the board decided to hold their next workshop meeting in either Palenville or Kiskatom with subsequent workshop meetings being held in the hamlets.

Councilman McCulloch asked for an update regarding the ambulance in an accident. Supervisor Davis stated it has not been totaled. Jack is in the process with the adjuster assessing repairs.

Supervisor Davis stated the material which was asked for was sent to the union representative for Ambulance. Councilman Vosburgh will reach out to Charlie Demarest in Highway regarding their negotiations.

With no further business a motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Councilman Giordiano seconded by Councilwoman Scannapieco. Meeting adjourned 6:49 pm.
