

Catskill Town Board Committee Meeting

Acting Supervisor Walsh opened the meeting with a moment of silent prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

He stated he phoned Michael Richardson and told him we will not be entertaining a change to the health insurance policy this year; however, Mike would like to meet with the board on August 17th.

He also stated he received a letter regarding ambulance negotiations for next year and would like to hire Michael as the liaison. This will be discussed at the next board meeting.

Councilman Smith stated he met with the owners of the Clark House and the Code Enforcement Officer regarding a noise complaint. He stated they complained to the Sheriff's Office and the person on the desk told them the noise ordinance is unenforceable. They then called the Code Enforcement Office. He stated they next met with the Clark's together and told them the State Law and that law is enforced by state officers.

Councilman Antonelli asked if they are fixing cars. Councilman Smith stated they said they are fixing cars for friends. He stated the Clark's feel there is something vindictive going on. He stated they are losing business and we need to protect existing businesses.

Acting Supervisor Walsh stated he will write a letter to the Sheriff asking about the response to the Clarks. He stated he should be made aware of what was said by his department.

Councilman Smith stated there is a sign outside the Goddess's residence stating the Town spent \$100,000 in order to eliminate their civil rights.

With no further comments a motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Councilman Antonelli and seconded by Councilman Smith. Meeting ended 6:44 pm.
