

Catskill Town Board Committee Meeting
Catskill Town Hall
November 14, 2012 6:30 pm

Attendance: Joseph Leggio, Supervisor; Robert Antonelli, Councilman; Pat Walsh, Councilman, Elizabeth Izzo, Town Clerk

Supervisor Leggio opened the meeting with a moment of silent prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance. The first order of business is the property of Mr. Pecora. He would like Code Enforcement to get quotes to clean up the property. Motion presented by Supervisor Leggio and seconded by Councilman Antonelli to have Code Enforcement Office receive quotes to clean up the property. Vote: 3 Yes 2 Absent (Lennon & Carlson) Motion accepted.

Supervisor Leggio stated the next order of business is the property owned by Karen Roberts. He stated provided it is cleaned up and suitable with Code no action will be taken but if not, will be cleaned up. Councilman Walsh stated she should have 10 days to clean up the current violations. Motion presented by Councilman Antonelli and seconded by Councilman Walsh to authorize the Code Office solicit quotes to clean up the property. Vote: 3 Yes 2 Absent (Lennon & Carlson) Motion accepted.

Supervisor Leggio moved on to the Senior Center. Councilman Antonelli stated the crushed stone and the binder is all that will be done this year. It will settle and then in the spring will put the top coat on. He stated Baxter will do his part for Irving School. Councilman Antonelli stated this is under state contract. He stated Peckham didn't want to quote the work as they sell blacktop to the other businesses. The same business will do both our portion and the private portion of the property. He stated there is a separate price for the side parking lot where the Village dug it up. Motion by Councilman Walsh and seconded by Councilman Antonelli to have A. Colarusso start work on the project. Vote: 3 Yes 2 Absent (Lennon & Carlson) Motion accepted.

Supervisor Leggio stated the bids for the ambulance will be in the paper with the bid opening on November 30th at 3 pm. He asked if there was any further comment. Chris Sutherland notified the board the fire company had no costs incurred from Hurricane Sandy. With no further comment a motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Councilman Walsh and seconded by Councilman Antonelli. Meeting ended 6:45 pm.
