

TOWN BOARD COMMITTEE MEETING – November 15, 2017

The Town Board of the Town of Catskill held their committee meeting on Wednesday, November 15, 2017 at Town Hall. The meeting commenced directly after the public hearing with the Pledge of Allegiance. The following members were present:

Supervisor Davis stated we have a couple resolutions to adopt. Supervisor Davis asked Councilman Antonelli to make the following resolution as his last official budget for the town:

Resolution #105-2017 with motion by Councilman Antonelli, second by Councilmen Giordiano, McCulloch, Vosburgh & Supervisor Davis adopting the 2018 Preliminary Budget as the 2018 Final Budget for the Town of Catskill for fiscal year 2018. Adopted Vote: 5 Yes

Resolution #106-2017 with motion by Councilman McCulloch, second by Councilman Giordiano abandoning Spooky Hollow Road in the Hamlet of Leeds. Adopted Vote: 5 Yes

Supervisor Davis stated we received an email from American Legion who would like to use the ballfield in the spring of 2018. Councilman McCulloch stated they will need to sign the agreement like everyone else who request to use the field.

Supervisor Davis stated we received the new premium for insurance coverage. It is a little higher as we have new equipment.

Supervisor Davis mentioned the ambulance contract and we are close to signing off on it.

Open enrollment for medical insurance as well as workplace and harassment training has been scheduled for December 5th beginning 9 am. Town Hall will be closed until 1 pm as this is mandatory attendance for all employees.

Future discussion will need to be held regarding after hour use for the Senior Center.

With no further comment a motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Councilman Antonelli second by Councilman Giordiano. Meeting ended 6:57 pm.
