Supervisor McCulloch opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

RESOLUTIONS:

Resolution # 153-2024 on motion of Councilman Giordiano, second Councilwoman Scannapieco to reappoint Raymond McNeany to the Board of Assessment Review with the term October 1, 2024 to September 30, 2029. Adopted Vote: 5 Yes

Resolution # 154-2024 on motion of Councilwoman Scannapieco, second Councilman Kozloski to purchase the Kubota Excavator in the amount of \$58,987.34 on state bid using ARPA funding. Adopted Vote: 5 Yes

Resolution # 155-2024 on motion of Councilwoman Scannapieco, second Councilman Espel to renew the GIS Hosting with CHA in the amount of \$6,400 for 2025. Adopted Vote: 5 Yes

Supervisor McCulloch mentioned the second meeting for a county-wide ambulance service was held. All the towns are interested and the main concern is employees being absorbed by the service and not losing their jobs and the residents being served rightly. All board members agreed it should be a county service and not outsourced by the county. There will be more meetings and then public hearings. No decision is remotely ready.

Councilman Giordiano stated the scoreboard will be up soon. The pickleball court construction may start in the next week or two weather permitting. Supervisor McCulloch would like the company to quote maintenance for a couple of years.

Councilman Giordiano wants to meet with the school to have them look at the items in the buildings at the field so we can begin to clean them out.

Supervisor McCulloch pulled the board. Councilman Espel would like to advertise for a second dog control officer with a stipend of \$2,500. Supervisor McCulloch stated the fuel management system at the Highway Department is moving forward though it will not be completed this year.

With no further comment, a Happy Thanksgiving to all. The meeting ended at 6:41 pm on motion of Councilman Espel, second Councilwoman Scannapieco.
