

Emergency Meeting Catskill Town Board

Supervisor McCulloch opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance. The purpose of the meeting was to pass an emergency declaration for the culvert washout on Pennsylvania Avenue.

Resolution # 60-2025 Emergency Declaration, Culvert Washout 58 Pennsylvania Ave.

WHEREAS, the Town Highway Superintendent Shawn Beers has reported a failure of the culvert and roadway near 58 Pennsylvania Avenue; and

WHEREAS, Delaware Engineering DPC inspected and evaluated conditions around the failure and the stability of the remaining roadway, and determined it unsafe and a risk to public safety; and

WHEREAS, the Town is applying for State Funding dedicated to repair of this culvert and roadway; so

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town of Catskill determines and resolves the following:

1. The Town resolves that the conditions represent an emergency affecting public property and/or the safety or property of Town residents.
2. Authorizes the Supervisor sign such agreements and documents as needed to affect execution of contract and agreements and commencement of work.
