Supervisor Davis called the meeting to order. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. She welcomed all in attendance.

At 6:32 pm Councilman Giordiano entered the meeting.

CORRESPONDENCE:

Copy of letter to GC Highway from Dept of Army Corp of Engineers regarding their permit application stabilization of the river bank in the Village of Catskill. *Supervisor Davis stated DEC is the lead agency.*

Community Action Weatherization Program for income eligible homeowners.

Monitoring notice NYSDOH Water District No. 1- all 2018 sampling has been completed.

PKHB Town Justice Audit of court dockets/accounting. *Supervisor Davis stated other than some suggestions regarding ledgers and timing all is good. Thanked the Clerks and Justices.*

NYSEFC approval engineering report for Leeds/JH Sewer District. *Supervisor Davis stated we are almost complete with the exercise.*

Notice from Charter Communications of new point of contact.

Letter from Commercial Instruments & Alarm System of merger with Doyle Security Systems. *Supervisor Davis had a conversation with George June and cameras. Will address at Department Head meeting.*

Email from Marge Riley requesting use of the Ricky Cramer Ball field for the American Legion baseball season. *Supervisor Davis would like all organizations to sit down together with us regarding the field. Councilman Giordiano stated the concession stand will no longer be used.*

Email from Eric Joyce, CCSD Athletic Director, for the school's use of the ballfield 2019.

Email from NYSDOT regarding Manitou's Revenge Ultramarathon use of state highways through our municipality. NYSDOT has no objection to the event and is asking for our concurrence. *Will send acknowledgement of concurrence.*

NEW BUSINESS:

Proposal roof replacement – Cemetery: The roof suffered damage with the last storm. The adjuster submitted estimate to replacement of the rear slope. A quote was received to replace the section damaged and to replace the entire roof. *Resolution # 15-19 on motion of Councilman McCulloch second by Councilwoman Scannapieco to accept the quote from Tri-Pow'R Roofing & Paining to replace the entire roof for \$8,200. Adopted Vote: 4 Yes 1 Absent*

Supervisor Davis asked if any board members had any other business. No one had anything further to discuss.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Vincent Seeley – approached the board about coming up with ideas for transportation from the Village to Leeds; possibly a shuttle. Supervisor Davis is having a meeting to discuss a shuttle from Palenville to the Falls and will see if that idea can be looked at for the Village of Catskill too. Councilman McCulloch stated to ask the County to increase their stops or loops for their shuttle. Supervisor Davis will draft a letter to our legislators and touch base with Economic Development.

Rosana Thompson – approached the board regarding the project on Mossy Hill Rd. She would like to know why the comprehensive plan is not being implemented. She is considering a lawsuit to stop the Planning Board from permitting until the comp plan is put into action and she and her neighbors are serious about suing to stop the development on Mossy Hill.

Councilman McCulloch stated to send a letter to the Planning Board decisions should be based on the comprehensive plan. It is a living document and can be changed. Supervisor Davis stated we will talk to the Planning Board. Town Attorney Smith gave an overview of the Planning Board regulations. Ms. Thompson is concerned regarding the anger she hears about the Kaaterskill decision, Tiny Tines and the landfill. Supervisor Davis stated they can talk to the Planning Board about the comp plan but the Town Board represents all the voices in the Town (for and against development) and the Planning Board is an independent entity.

With no further discussion Supervisor Davis asked for a motion to enter into executive session to discuss a legal matter. She asked Town Attorney Smith and Town Clerk Izzo to remain. No further business will be conducted once executive session ends. Motion to enter into executive session at 7:21 pm by Councilman Giordano second by Councilwoman Scannapieco.

Motion to exit executive session and end the meeting was made by Councilman McCulloch second by Councilwoman Scannapieco. Meeting ended 8:43 pm.
