RESOLUTIONS:

Commitment to Provide Assistance to Low- and Moderate-Income Persons to Connect to the Cementon Sanitary Sewer System. *Resolution # 82-2025 on motion of Councilwoman Scannapieco, second by Councilman Kozloski to commit to assist low- and moderate-income persons by providing grants to pay for proposed new sanitary sewer connections within Town Sewer District # 4 serving the hamlet of Cementon. Adopted Vote: 4 Yes 1 Absent (McCulloch)*

Reappointment Audre Higbee as Assessor for the Town of Catskill. *Resolution # 83-2025 on motion of Councilwoman Scannapieco, second by Councilman Espel to appoint Audre Higbee as Assessor for the Town of Catskill for a term beginning October 1, 2025 through September 30, 2031. Adopted Vote: 4 Yes 1 Absent (McCulloch)*

Appointment Garrett Jeune as Seasonal Cemetery Worker. *Resolution # 84-2025 on motion of Councilwoman Scannapieco, second Councilman Kozloski to appoint Garrett Jeune as seasonal cemetery worker pending pre-employment screening at a rate of pay of \$16.15 per hour. Adopted Vote: 4 Yes 1 Absent (McCulloch)*

Abandonment of part of road, Long Alley, Palenville. *Resolution # 85-2025 on motion of Councilman Kozloski, second by Councilwoman Scannapieco to abandon that portion of Long Alley that is unmaintained by the Town and has not been traveled or used as a highway for over six years and authorize the Town Attorney draft a quit claim deed conveying any interest the town may have in said abandoned roadway to the adjoining land owners, to the center line. Adopted Vote: 4 Yes 1 Absent (McCulloch)*

Town of Catskill Ambulance Service Controlled Substances and Alcohol Testing Policy – *Resolution # 86-2025 on motion of Councilman Espel, second by Councilman Kozloski to approve the revised Controlled Substances and Alcohol Testing policy for the Town of Catskill Ambulance Service. Adopted Vote: 4 Yes 1 Absent (McCulloch)*
