

CATSKILL TOWN BOARD MONTHLY MEETING – September 4, 2018

The Town Board of the Town of Catskill held their monthly meeting with the public hearing on the Local Law for Campground Regulations reconvening on Tuesday, September 4, 2018 at Catskill Town Hall at 6:30 pm. The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance. The following members were present:

The Public Hearing for Local Law 3 of 2018 was reconvened. Supervisor Davis stated the law has been reviewed, edited and circulated to all. She asked if there were any comments from the public, board, counsel or planning.

Bonnie Schroeder appreciated the board reaching out to the campground owners but was concerned with Section 120-10c of the proposed law.

Supervisor Davis responded that anyone who owns a campground now would have need to come to the Planning Board as it would trigger a site plan review by adjusting the site. Ms. Schroeder stated she never had to before. Mr. Fishman stated a house or a campsite would be subject to a site plan review whether it be new or not.

Further discussion ensued regarding this topic. The section of the local law stayed as written.

An audience member asked if there was recourse if the law is passed if it could revisit the law and modify. Councilman McCulloch stated yes. If the law needs to be amended it can be.

Supervisor Davis asked if there was further comment. With no further comment the public hearing was adjourned on motion by Councilman McCulloch, second by Councilman Giordiano. 7:14 pm.

Supervisor Davis proceeded directly with the Town Board meeting. She asked if the board wishes to adopt the local law. *Resolution # 61-2018 on motion of Councilman Giordiano, second by Councilman McCulloch to adopt Local Law 3 of 2018 Campground Regulations. Adopted Vote: 5 Yes*

NEW BUSINESS:

Supervisor Davis stated bids were received for replacement of the garage doors at the Highway Department. Two bids were received. *Resolution #62-18 on motion by Councilman Giordiano, second by Councilwoman Scannapieco awarding the bid for replacement of Highway Garage doors to C & R Overhead Garage Door, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$22,825. Adopted Vote: 5 Yes*

Supervisor Davis mentioned the Department Head meetings and if they day/date should be changed. After a brief discussion, the meetings will be kept the first Thursday of the month at 9:30 am.

Supervisor Davis mentioned the need to schedule budget workshop meetings. *Budget workshop meetings are scheduled for October 10th at 5:30 pm, October 17th at 5:30 pm and October 23rd at 5:30 pm. All at Town Hall.*

Supervisor Davis stated we are working with Athens regarding the ambulance contract. With no further business a motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Councilman Giordiano, second by Councilman McCulloch. Meeting ended 7:34 pm.
